How at risk of fire is your home?

As part of a our free, home fire safety visit we will assess your home and offer advice on how to make it safer; where appropriate we will fit a smoke alarm.

The home fire safety visit is usually for people regarded as having a higher risk of fire in the home, such as:

- Older people living alone

• People with mobility, vision or hearing impairments • People accessing mental health service users • Those liable to intoxication through alcohol and/or drug use Visits shouldn't last more than a few minutes and could significantly help prevent fires.
