Starting from October we will be running a trial of Sunday Afternoon Tea (3PM-5PM). We hope this will be a good excuse for people to get out of the house and meet others over a cup of tea and cake. We would like as many people as possible to benefit and are asking local over 70 year olds to choose between Fulham Lunch Club and Fulham Sunday Afternoon Tea and attend only one of them each week.

ELECTRIC AND GAS SMART METERS Are being rolled out across the UK now. Every household will have the opportunity to upgrade to a smart meter, at no additional cost, by 2020. Everyone will have a chance to decide whether they wish to have a SMART meter installed by their provider and now is probably a good time to think about any pros and cons.

Here are a few points to help you make the right decision for you:

- Smart meters will bring an end to estimated bills and show us how much energy we're using in near real time and in pounds and pence.
- You will receive an in-house display, which shows exactly how much energy you're using, as you use it.
- If you change suppliers your (1st generation) SMART meter will lose its smart features.
- Your SMART meter will be installed by a trained installer at NO EXTRA COST.




- The installer should spend time with you explaining how to operate the inhouse display so that you can use it confidently on your own.
- The installation will take approximately 1 hour.
- When you are eligible depends on many factors and your supplier will be in touch when your smart meter is ready to be installed (before 2020). In the future:

Switching between suppliers will be quicker and easier and you will not need to change your (2nd generation) SMART meter each time you change suppliers.

Support for People with Sight Loss

Central West and North London Vision is a relatively new society supporting people with registered sight-loss in LBHF. We provide information about assistive technology that could benefit people who are visually impaired from



the hi-tech like screen reader programmes for computers to the really practical like a liquid level indicator for aiding people when making a cup of tea. We have access to volunteers for social events and arranging visits to places of interest that may include a touch/tactile tour - we recently visited the Victoria and Albert Museum for a tactile tour which those people who attended enjoyed very much. Our Impact

The mean age of our beneficiaries is just over 80. In July 2017 we conducted a survey with 65 of them and received this feedback:

88% report having more social contact as a result of our befriending visits

90% report having more social contact as a result of our social clubs

85% report getting out more as a result of our help with transporting and escorting 93% report being able to use their garden more and feeling more supported or more independent as a result of our help

92% report being more independent as a result of being helped with practical tasks (DIY, shopping, errands, etc)


