Digital skills were essential to keeping in touch with others, staying addressing informed. feelings of loneliness, or increasing one's mental and physical wellbeing. One of our learners tells us: "I started using the computer a lot; more than I ever had, since I chose self-isolate. It's satisfying, I like to look things up, Google them." 107 older people Fulham accessed our Digital Inclusion Project between April 2020 March 2021, receiving 317 support calls from Digital Skills our volunteers.

Our Digital Inclusion project now wraps itself around our other projects, allowing their continued for during delivery lockdowns. For example, Our facilitators



utilised digital platforms to deliver both Chair Based Exercise and Art online; and our Gardening projects came to include online Health and Wellbeing sessions Virtual Open Garden events. We registered a staggering 1,668 online attendances.
