### Gardening

Free support with garden clearance, lawn care, hedge trimming, and pruning. Eligibility criteria:

- Are unable to manage their garden, balcony or outdoor space due to age or disability
- Have no one else available to assist
- Cannot afford a private gardening service
- To ensure fairness, there is a 12-month gap between visits.

### Minor Home Repairs & Decorating

Free support with small tasks like putting up shelves, fixing fittings, replacing bulbs, and small decorating tasks etc.

### Befriending

Regular befriending through regular home visits and telephone calls from a trusted volunteer.

### Good Neighbour Scheme

Support with domestic tasks, medication delivery, access to the community, assistance with correspondence, shopping, etc.

### Digital Support

Digital drop-in every Monday between 11-1pm at Rosaline Hall. At home visits for 1:1 digital support about your device.
