and the imminent launch of our crowd funding campaign for Solar Panels at Rosaline Solar panels have halved in cost in the last decade while energy bills continue to rise. Investment now will enable us to reduce carbon footprint, promote sustainable energy consumption into the future reinvest energy and back into our savings community activity. A similar at the Masboro project Centre has all but reduced their bills to zero. Projected benefits per annum include carbon ton of a savings, almost 4,000 kwh generated and up to £500 energy bill savings! If we can demonstrate community support the London Borough Hammersmith of and Fulham (LBHF) will donate up to 50% of capital costs. A pledge of as little as £2 will enable us to build our case. We hope to go live with our campaign within the next month.
