Fulham Good Neighbours Temporary Move

Why is the move happening? The Fulham Good Neighbours premises, Rosaline hall, will be refurbished to include an expanded kitchen, additional storage and soundproofing. This will improve our facilities so we can continue to provide our services for years to come.

Where are you moving to? Staff and clubs are moving to Dawes Road Hub, a well-known community centre and hub which is located up the road towards Fulham Broadway.

- **Address:** Dawes Road Hub, 20 Dawes Road, SW6 7EN
- **Relocation period:** Monday 17 August - Monday 16 November 2026.

Is there any other change I should be aware of?

We are updating our telephone system so that it is easier for you to speak to the right staff member. We are introducing the ability to select the options based on the service you require. Leave a message on the extension and the staff member will get back to you.

Will my club still run? Clubs will run normally with slight change in timings, all services will run as usual.

What if I need to see a staff member without prior notice/appointment? We ask you to attend Dawes Road Hub only during social clubs hours or via an appointment. Reach out to us by telephone or email if you need support.

Free support with garden clearance, lawn care, hedge trimming, and pruning. Eligibility criteria:

- Are unable to manage their garden, balcony or outdoor space due to age or disability
- Have no one else available to assist
- Cannot afford a private gardening service
- To ensure fairness, there is a 12-month gap between visits.

Minor Home Repairs & Decorating

Free support with small tasks like putting up shelves, fixing fittings, replacing bulbs, and small decorating tasks etc.

Befriending

Regular befriending through regular home visits and telephone calls from a trusted volunteer.

Good Neighbour Scheme

Support with tasks including medication collection, access to the community, assistance with correspondence, shopping, etc.

Digital Support

Digital drop-in every Monday between 11-1pm at Rosaline Hall. At home visits for 1:1 digital support about your device.
