“Fulham Through the Seasons” Mural Unveiling

On 29th October 2024, Fulham Good Neighbours, in partnership with Higgins Partnerships, proudly unveiled “Fulham Through the Seasons”. This a vibrant 14-metre mural was created by Art Club members, who have collectively lived in Fulham for 470 years, capturing the borough’s rich history and character.

Now displayed on the hoardings at the Hartopp and Lannoy project site on Dawes Road, the mural showcases Fulham’s iconic landscapes, changing seasons, and deep-rooted community spirit. Local residents and supporters gathered to celebrate the unveiling and joined us for a celebratory tea at Rosaline Hall where contribution of each member to this community masterpiece was celebrated.



The mural, curated by London-based artist and designer **Roopa S Basu**, who also serves as the Art Club’s facilitator, represents Fulham’s past, present, and future. Its central oak tree symbolises the strength and growth of Fulham Good Neighbours over more than 50 years, framed by depictions of local parks, bustling markets, and native wildlife.

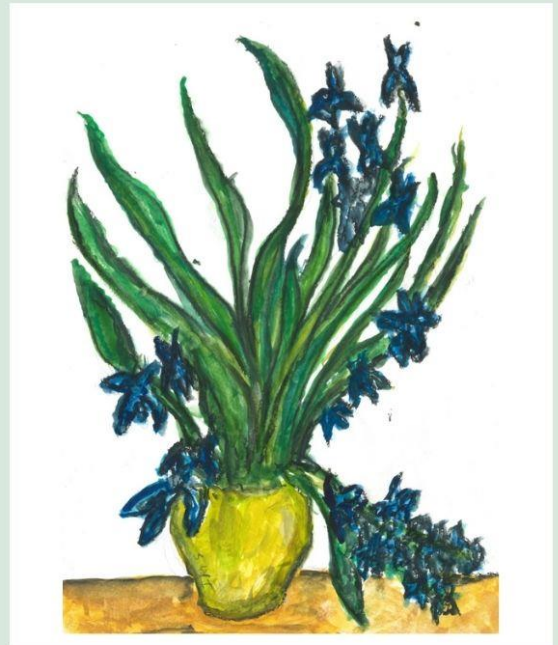
Upcoming sessions will take place on 7th November at Sycamore House, 12th November at Action on Disability, and 3rd December as a virtual meeting.
