- a clean Driving License B category;
- a work/business element for volunteering on your insurance policy (this can be added by your insurer at no extra cost).

- A friendly and cheerful manner
- Patience
- Good listening skills
- Good time keeping skills
- Good problem-solving skills

Any other information

We will conduct a DBS and reference check.

How many hours you need to give, when and where:

You would normally volunteer as and when required depending on your availability and the tasks you wish to take on. This could be as often as once a week or as rarely as once every few months.

What training will be necessary and available:

There is no formal training and you should accept only the tasks you are able and confident to accomplish. You will be provided with a general induction to your volunteering role at Fulham Good Neighbours.

Who will supervise you:

Your supervisor will be the Volunteer Coordinator for Community Projects
